




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The 15th Certified Human Resource Professional (CHRP) examinations, held from the 12th to the 20th of June 2024, marked a significant milestone in the history of professional HR certification.

This examinations was carried out in seven centre around the country; Nairobi (KCA University), Nanyuki (Kenya institute of Management-KIM), Thika (Mt Kenya University), Eldoret (Mt Kenya University), Nakuru Mt Kenya), Mombasa (CHRM college) and Kisumu (Maseno University) for both the Old and Revised CHRP curriculum.

- c) A bachelor degree from a recognized university.
- d) Equivalent qualification as determined by KNQA.


